

BANQUET PRAYER VISION

A Request from the Executive Director

The only way for us to move forward is with the beautiful grace and favor of the Lord. The Board of Directors, staff, and I have been praying for the Lord's direction for the 2021 Banquet Season. Please see below the points for which I would like your attention in prayer as we prepare for our banquets: Wayne County, September 16; Glynn County, September 23; and Camden County, September 30.

I believe the Lord has directed me to encourage the friends of this ministry to set aside time for prayer and, if you can, fasting. As you are led by the Lord consider setting aside all or some of the six Wednesdays before our events in Wayne, Camden and Glynn County (July 21, 28, August 4, 11, 18, and September 1) for prayer and fasting. If those dates don't work any dates would be greatly appreciated. Please remember that fasting can include eating less at your three meals, giving up one meal, dessert, social media, or a television show. Seek the Lord and follow His creative lead!

I am grateful for your prayer coverage. I am desperate for the Lord's intervention, and I know it can only be done well with His blessing. As it says in Matthew 19:26, "And looking at them Jesus said to them, 'With people this is impossible, but with God all things are possible.'"

As you pray and/or fast, I would appreciate your agreement in prayer with me on the following:

For the following banquet financial goals to be met:

1. Sponsorship goal of \$124,000 exceeded: Jesup: \$17,000; Saint Marys: \$17,000; Brunswick: \$90,000.
2. Banquet goal of \$410,000 exceeded: Jesup: \$55,000; Saint Marys: \$80,000; Brunswick: \$275,000.
3. Addition of 500 new monthly pledge supporters: Jesup: 100; Saint Marys: 100; and 300 Brunswick.

For the following banquet requests to be met:

1. For the additional hosts / hostesses needed for tables: Jesup: 45; Saint Marys: 45; and Brunswick: 110.
2. For our table hosts to have great success and ease in inviting guests to the banquet and fill their tables.
3. For guests that the Lord wants to attend to act on His direction to attend.
4. Ministry testimonies to be established and properly presented at the banquet.
5. The peace of God to rule over every volunteer and staff member involved with the banquet.
6. For the banquet staff to work efficiently and provide all services in a timely professional manner.
7. Proper operation of all equipment and essentials for the banquet and beautiful weather for the event.

For the following ministry goals to be met:

1. For potential volunteers to respond for each center: Jesup: 20; Saint Marys: 20; and Brunswick: 50.
2. Funds and staff to provide for the new Medical Mobile Unit.
3. Broader outreach with Forgiven and Set Free, our Post-Abortion Bible Study. Pray for twenty women to experience healing by going through the bible study.
4. More abortion-vulnerable clients in the upcoming twelve months.
5. More abortion-vulnerable clients to carry to term. Pray specifically for 100 women to choose life.
6. More salvation experiences for clients in the upcoming twelve months. Pray specifically for 100 salvations.
7. Increased youth participation in the programming of BRAVEheart.
8. The ministry to stay in the black with \$250,000 in reserve funds for lean months, so ministry, rather than funds, will remain the focus.
9. Wisdom and direction for the Board of Directors, staff, and volunteers.
10. Our nation and its leadership to honor the biblical values of the sanctity of human life and marriage.
11. Receptivity to adoption as a viable option for clients and women facing unplanned pregnancy.
